I am writing in response to your March 16, 2018 public record request for certain information pertaining to Professor David Garcia.

With respect to your question on the courses taught by Professor Garcia from the period of April 12, 2017 to date, our records show the following:

Spring 2017

EPA 555, Translating Research for Education Change, 19 students (Tempe)

TEL 712, Mixed Methods of Inquiry, 20 students (Online)

Fall 2017

EPA 591/BUS 593, Intellectual Fusion Applied Learning Lab (co-listed and co-taught with W.P. Carey), 35 students across both co-listed sections (Tempe)

TEL 712, Mixed Methods of Inquiry, 17 students (Online)

Spring 2018

EPA 555, Translating Research for Education Change, 14 students (Tempe)

TEL 712, Mixed Methods of Inquiry, 14 students (Online)

For context, EPA 555 is required for students in the Educational Policy M.A. program and the class size is generally set by the first-year cohort size. TEL 712 is required for students in the Leadership and Innovation EdD. Program and so the class size is similarly set by the size of the cohort. EPA 591/BUS 593 was part of the first year that the face-to-face MBA program ran with the Intellectual Fusion Applied Learning Lab, designed as problem-based, interdisciplinary classes.

Effective January 1, 2018, Dr. Garcia's academic year salary is \$82,063.20.
