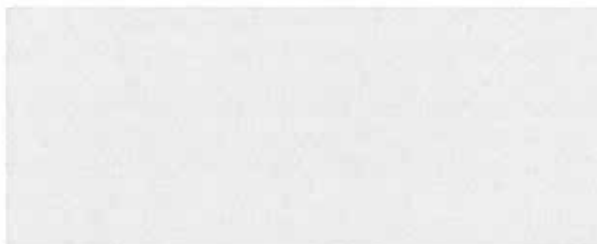
Va. Gov. Northam won't resign, a spokeswoman says. He's expected to say racist photo was mistakenly published on his yearbook page.

Virginia Gov. Ralph Northam (D) plans to tell the public Saturday that he will not resign because he does not believe that he appears in a racist photograph from his 1984 medical school yearbook, according to a person close to the governor.

His explanation runs counter to his public apology Friday, when he said that he appeared in what he called a "clearly racist" image.
